

The course is run on well maintained forest road. Aid is set up approximately every 5-6 miles. Approximate cumulative elevation changes:

Out/up: 3500' total climb, 1900' total descent

Back/Down: 1900' total climb and 3500' total descent (see profile on next page)

You may also run the 25K ascent (fun run) only, but you will need to find your own ride back.

Course closes by 5 pm. Early starts are encouraged if you are unable to complete the 50K under 8 hours. Note: There will be a few awards given – early starters are not eligible for awards.


