Course: A picturesque climb over Pinnacle Mountain followed by an out-and-back along the shore of Lake Maumelle. Course includes six miles of asphalt and the remainder on scenic, rocky, single-track trail. Several highway crossings will be involved. There will be no traffic control. Please be responsible and be careful!

Trail: The Ouachita Trail is a single-track recreational footpath, and is permanently marked with blue blazes. Additional markers will be out. Approximately two miles of Pinnacle Mountain trails will be utilized on the "out" section only.

Aid: Eleven staffed aid stations for 50-mile; seven for 50Km. There may be an eight-mile trail section with no aid. Carry a bottle. Drop bags will be taken to the 15 mile aid station, and to the turnaround point for the 50 mile. Post-race food will be provided.

Awards: Finisher awards for both races. Technical shirts to all entrants. 13-hour time limit for both races.

Entry fee: \$55 if post marked by April 5th. \$70 thereafter. Please make check payable to Arkansas Traveller 100.

I also understand that the race director has the right to refuse any entry, and that my registration fee is non-refundable.

2009-2010 Ultra Trail Series Update – Stan Ferguson, UTS Coordinator

With only the Ouachita Trail 50 remaining, all but a few of the King and Queen of the Trail spots are essentially set. In the Open King division, PT has pulled to within striking range of Mark DenHerder. With a 22.5 point lead, will Mark lay it up and play it safe? We'll see on April 17th. Shirley Hyman has the overall Queen title reasonably secured, but Kim Johnson can overtake sister-in-law Chrissy for the Master Queen spot with a supreme showing at OT50. No pressure. For the Super-Duper Senior Queen—it's Winner-Take-All between Ann Moore and Rosemary Rogers. I'm looking for a Smack-Down!

My feeling is that the UTS in its new format has been a success. The sixty participants who signed up this first year significantly surpassed my expectations. I've solicited feedback on the format for much of the year (and still welcome any comments), and virtually all of it has been positive. There are still a few old-school hold-outs, and also still a few questions that come up. Why the changes and new features? A brief recap: having a sign-up process makes points calculation easier, and makes more sense than cluttering up the series standings with people who merely happened to run a particular ultra or trail race in Arkansas. The nominal entry fee is to provide a small source of funding for awards. The age-qualified scoring is to make the points for older runners more equitable between the different races. The new "Miles" category and participation-style award was mostly inspired by talking with David Horton about the Lynchburg Ultra Series and Beast Series. Those series have fewer events, but require completion of every one—no exceptions. Having more events, but allowing the option of missing a few runs seemed like a nice compromise. Including miles for run leaders and volunteers makes sense—since without them, none of the races or the series would exist. Again—if you have thoughts or suggestions, please let me or one of the other board members know.

Look for information on the UTS Awards Ceremony and AURA meeting in the next issue of the AUR.

Additional Note: An unfortunate run strategy by a 3 Days of Syllamo participant resulted in the cancellation of the third stage of that event. While obviously no points could be calculated, miles for the 20K have been awarded to UTS participants who still gave up much of their Sunday to search for the lost runner. I've tried to get a full listing of those individuals, but please contact me if I missed anyone (you can check the website to see the list).


